## **Board Meeting Minutes**

#### 1. Finances:

Paul, the Treasurer reported bank account balance and addition of new members. A few members found the club on the internet. Renewals are due by the end of March. Notifications will be now handled by the Treasurer.

He also reported on the progress of the new online payment system. Jim Betz volunteered to be the owner of the PCI compliance for the system. Jim and Paul, along with Steve Peterka are hoping to have the online payment system up on the web in a few months. Vicki noted that the membership form needs to include a discount for VTR members, along with NAMGBR members.

#### 2. Memberships:

Jim Webb, VP of Membership and Paul will oversee the membership list. *Action:* Larry will send additional decals to Jim, who sends out the welcome letters to new members.

#### 3. Newsletter/Facebook/Website

Members are highly encouraged to send articles and photos to Vicki for the newsletter and Charlie Lowe for the Facebook page.

Jim Betz noted that the webpage for the Car Show has a header that says Eastern Region. This needs to be changed. Moss Motors has included this and not South Bend in their list of car shows. This led to a short discussion of other pages that need to be reviewed or updated.

Action: Randy asked all Board members to look at the website and send comments to Vicki. She will compile a list and present at the next meeting for discussion.

#### 4. List of Automotive Garages that work on LBCs

Randy noted that he received a question concerning repair shops. He asked where the information is available. Vicki replied that the short articles on a few shops that Paul, Phillip, and PJ found were included in the newsletter, but that this information could go on the website. PJ noted that he will be contacting a local shop to see if they work on LBCs.

*Action:* This project should no longer be included on future agendas. Vicki will compile a list of garages to include on website.

#### 5.. Car Show

Jim Betz reported that he is working on sponsorships. He is also working on getting plaques and trophies (which will include the year). The car show's poster has been completed. Phillip asked for the year to be added. Those seeking posters should contact Jim. Jim asked if the thick book about South Bend needs to be included in each goody bag. 
