Hello All,

The upcoming USGA Senior Championship from June 27, 2019 to June 30, 2019, at Notre Dame, will not affect our show as much as we originally thought. The crowd size expected for Sunday, the day of our show, should be less than 30,000 based on attendance figures since 2013. Last year's Senior Championship only had 31,000 attend the Sunday round. The crowd size that is now being advertised is "up to 100,000 golf fans," which is actually the expected attendance total for all four days combined. The Sunday total for the tournament will be a bit more than a quarter of the fans that show up for ND football games. Traffic will no longer be an issue, so don't let the golf tournament at Notre Dame keep you from attending our car show.

The driving season has started with our trip to the National Truck and Automobile Museum in Auburn, Indiana.
