New Brands and Models

- **Longbow:** This British EV startup is developing lightweight sports cars, aiming to emulate the classic British sports car ethos with its "Featherweight Electric Vehicles" (FEVs). The Speedster will be the first available, weighing under 1000kg and offering impressive performance for an EV.
- **Marcos:** The historic British sports car manufacturer is returning to production, with plans to release an all-new model and build continuation versions of its classic cars.

Established Brands and Models

• **Martin:** The company is focusing on its high-performance models, with the <u>Valkyrie</u> continuing its racing season in both IMSA and the FIA World Endurance Championship. Aston Martin is also celebrating 60 years of its Volante models with anniversary editions.

• **McLaren:** The new flagship McLaren W1, a lightweight plug-in hybrid hypercar, is set to debut in the first half of 2026. It will feature an in-house 4-liter twin-turbo V-8 engine and a track-oriented design inspired by Formula One.

Key Themes in Current News

- **Electrification:** The industry is seeing a push towards electric sports cars, with startups like Longbow championing lightweight EVs to capture the spirit of traditional sports cars.
- **Lightweighting:** There's a strong emphasis on reducing weight in the new generation of sports cars, a hallmark of classic British sports car design.
- **Hypercars and Endurance Racing:** Leading British brands are involved in the hypercar segment, with cars like the Aston Martin Valkyrie competing in top-level endurance racing series.
